What is Provider-Based Billing?

Provider-Based billing is a type of billing for services provided in a clinic or department that is considered part of a hospital facility. Provider-Based Billing has become a common model of practice for health systems locally and around the U.S.

What changes occur with Provider-Based Billing?

Beginning September 1, 2025, visits to Thibodaux Regional Clinics will be classified as hospital outpatient services. As a result, billing statements will show two charges:

- Hospital Facility/Technical Services: For use of rooms, equipment, and support services.
- Physician and Clinical Professional Services: For care provided by your medical provider

Who is affected by this change?

- Patients with Traditional Medicare and Medicaid will see separate claims and experience a small increase in out-of-pocket costs (typically around \$25).
- Commercial insurance patients are generally unaffected.
- Supplemental insurance may cover additional charges.

Your care will remain unchanged; you will continue to see your regular providers without disruption.
