Abdominal surgery addresses conditions affecting the organs within the abdomen, including the appendix, colon, gallbladder, small intestine, and spleen.

From consultation through recovery, your care is guided by surgeons you know and trust.

Conditions we treat:

- **Appendix:** Appendicitis is a common emergency condition requiring prompt surgical removal of the appendix. In most cases, the appendix is removed using minimally invasive laparoscopic surgery, allowing for smaller incisions and faster recovery.
- **Colon:** Colon surgery may be required for conditions such as polyps, cancer, diverticulitis, inflammatory bowel disease, or fistulas. When possible, surgery is performed electively using minimally invasive techniques. Emergency situations may require open surgery.
- **Gallbladder:** Gallbladder surgery is commonly performed for gallstones or gallbladder dysfunction that causes pain or digestive symptoms. Most gallbladders are removed using laparoscopic surgery through small incisions.

- **Small Intestine:** Surgery of the small intestine may be needed for blockage, inflammation, tumors, bleeding, or injury. Obstruction caused by scar tissue from prior surgery is a common reason for intervention, and minimally invasive approaches may be used when appropriate.

- **Spleen:** The spleen plays an important role in filtering blood and supporting the immune system. Surgery may be required for blood disorders, enlargement, or traumatic injury. Splenectomy is often performed using minimally invasive techniques.

A minimally invasive approach

Whenever possible, abdominal surgery is performed using laparoscopic or robotic-assisted techniques, which compared to traditional surgery, may offer:

- Smaller incisions
- Less postoperative pain
- Shorter hospital stays
- Faster recovery
