How LINX® Works

GERD occurs when a weakened lower esophageal sphincter (LES) allows stomach acid to flow back into the esophagus.

LINX® is a flexible ring of tiny magnetic beads placed around the LES during a minimally invasive procedure.

- Helps keep the LES closed to prevent reflux
- Opens temporarily when you swallow
- Preserves normal stomach anatomy
